

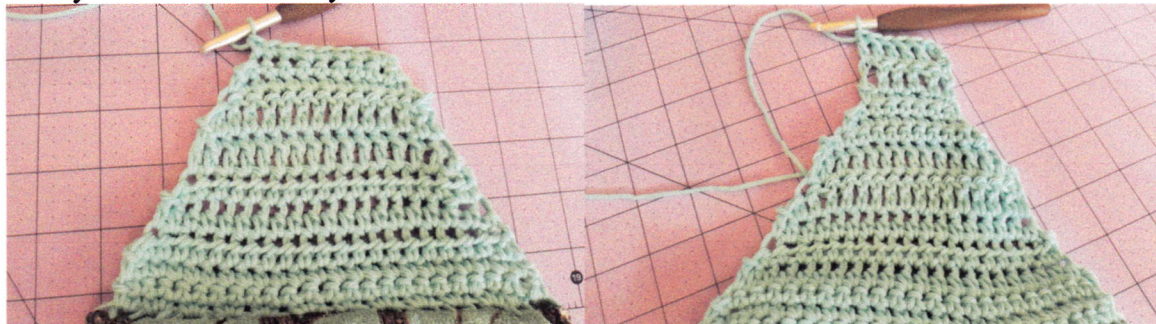
*Chain 1, turn your work, 1sc in every stitch back across. Repeat from * 1 more time (totaling 3 rows of single crochet. You should have the same number of stitches for each row).

*Turn your work, and 1 Half Double Crochet (HDC) into the next stitch over (Because you didn't chain 1, you will have less stitches for this row), and every stitch back across. Repeat from * until you have completed 3 rows of HDC (each of these rows should have 2 less stitches for each row, creating a slight angle on each edge forming a triangle towards the top).



*Turn your work, and 1 Double Crochet (dc) into the next stitch, and every stitch back across. Repeat from * 1 more time (completing 2 rows of dc).

*Turn your work, and 1sc into the next stitch, and every stitch back across. Repeat from * until you are down to only 6 stitches.



*Chain 3, turn your work, 1dc into the next stitch, and every stitch back across. Repeat from * until you have completed 5 rows of dc.
